Award	Organisation	Summary
£59,681	Cromarty Harbour Trust	The modernisation and updating of a listed structure to develop and enhance the facilities in the Harbour for the benefit of the community, visitors and users
£50,000	Wasps	Wasps Inverness Creative Academy will deliver affordable creative workspaces to help retain Highland creative talent and regenerate historic buildings at Midmills in the centre of Inverness
£40,538	Abriachan Forest Trust	To set up an outdoor Early Learning and Childcare provision in Abriachan's community woodland, particularly for families who are considered hard to reach
£58,099	Cantraybridge College	To extend the existing employability service for people with learning disabilities and/or autism to individuals in the local community (current service offered for college students only)
£39,960	Lairg and District Learning Centre	A business start-up mentoring service, dovetailing training and support sessions to transform fledgling business ideas into viable commercial enterprises
£80,000	Sleat Community Trust	To build a community shop with integral post office, and petrol station with offices on the upper floor of the building
£100,000	The Ledge	A climbing and adventure sports project located beside the Harbour in Inverness
£65,000	Plastic @ Bay	A recycling centre in Durness where marine plastic pollution washed up on local beaches are recycled into useful objects for resale (profits will be invested into local beach clean projects)
£40,000	Visit Inverness Loch Ness Ltd	Appointment of a full time Loch Ness Ranger who will undertake activities to improve the visitor experience around Loch Ness
£80,000	GlenWyvis Distillery Community Benefit Company	Provision of a visitor experience to 20,000 new visitors to Dingwall, linking the town of Dingwall to the Distillery by a 100% electric bus, thus increasing footfall on the High Street in Dingwall and supporting the town's regeneration
£100,000	Caol Regeneration Company Ltd	Delivery of marina facilities, including a slipway and café at the Caledonian Canal's West gateway, providing substantial social and economic benefits to local communities
£50,000	Morvern Community Development Company Ltd	Development and construction of nine affordable houses in Lochaline, Morvern (including three x one bedroom, three x two bedroom and three x three bedroom homes and associated services and landscaping)
£100,000	Glenurquhart Care Project	To deliver twelve community owned and run adaptable houses for the elderly adjacent to the Glenurquhart Centre in Drumnadrochit
£45,000	Rogart Development Trust	To renovate the Rogart Mart building as an all-year indoor/outdoor multi-purpose venue, creating social and economic benefits for the community of Rogart
£75,000	The Shieling Project	The final stage of infrastructure development at the Shieling project near Beauly to provide bothy accommodation, wash building, completed micro-dairy and extensive areas for cultivation
